



DC Future LPN Scholarship

Eligibility requirements

- You are a new student registering for the Fall 2026 quarter and enrolling in the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) Diploma program at Strayer.
- You meet all admission requirements as outlined in the [Strayer catalog](#).
- You are either a resident of Washington, D.C., or Virginia and you intend to complete your clinical requirements in D.C.
- This program is currently available only in Washington, D.C., and Virginia. Strayer University is not currently offering this program or accepting applications from residents in the following jurisdictions. Strayer University students who relocate to the following jurisdictions may not be able to complete fieldwork experiences, other program completion requirements, or obtain professional licensure in the jurisdictions: AK, AL, AR, AS, AZ, CA, CO, CT, DE, FL, GA, GU, HI, ID, IL, IN, KS, KY, LA, MA, MD, ME, MI, MN, MO, MP, MS, MT, NC, ND, NE, NH, NJ, NM, NV, NY, OH, OK, OR, PA, PR, RI, SC, SD, TN, TX, UT, VI, VT, WA, WI, WV, WY.
- Strayer University's Licensed Practical Nurse Diploma program will meet the educational requirements for professional licensure as a licensed practical nurse in Washington, D.C.. Washington, D.C. accepts completion of a nursing education program which was approved by the District of Columbia Board of Nursing and a passing score on the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN) exam. Strayer's program is approved by the District of Columbia Board of Nursing. Applicants will need to obtain a passing score on the NCLEX-PN exam. Applicants are advised that additional fees may be incurred in connection with mandatory examinations – whether nationally administered or imposed by local licensing authorities – as well as for license applications, background checks and compliance with other jurisdictional regulatory requirements. Furthermore, applicants may be required to satisfy ethical standards and demonstrate adherence to professional conduct rules as a condition of licensure.

Eligibility requirements

- Strayer University's Licensed Practical Nurse program will meet the educational requirements for licensure as a licensed practical nurse in Virginia. Virginia accepts completion of a state-approved program which contains state-specific clinical experience and a passing score on the national examination. Strayer's Licensed Practical Nurse program is approved by the District of Columbia Board of Nursing, and contains the state-specific clinical experience requirements. Applicants will need to obtain a passing score on the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN) examination. Applicants are advised that additional fees may be incurred in connection with mandatory examinations – whether nationally administered or imposed by local licensing authorities – as well as for license applications, background checks and compliance with other jurisdictional regulatory requirements. Furthermore, applicants may be required to satisfy ethical standards and demonstrate adherence to professional conduct rules as a condition of licensure.
- Disclaimer: Licensing agencies review each applicant's completed application materials – including education, exam scores, supervised fieldwork experience and criminal history – at the time the application is submitted to determine eligibility. Strayer University cannot guarantee eligibility for licensure, endorsement, salary advancement or other professional credentials.

Acknowledgements

- You understand and agree that once eligibility is confirmed, your tuition will be capped at \$1,312.50 per term up to a total of \$5,250.00. The tuition cap will only apply to tuition and, upon reaching the tuition cap threshold of \$5,250.00 for the eligible program, the scholarship will be applied to your student account on the first day of each quarter.
- In the quarters leading up to the tuition cap threshold for the eligible program, tuition paid to Strayer University for successfully completed courses, withdrawn courses, failed courses and charges for courses dropped before census, will apply as tuition paid toward the tuition cap. The recipient is responsible for funding these charges leading up to the tuition cap threshold. Once the tuition cap threshold is reached, the tuition for these course scenarios will be covered by Strayer.
- Reversed charges are excluded in all cases and will not count toward the tuition cap threshold.

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- Past-due balances accrued prior to reaching the tuition cap threshold will not be waived once the threshold is reached. Once the tuition paid threshold is reached, the tuition cap will only cover tuition charges for amounts in excess of the tuition cap threshold. In some circumstances, recipients may complete their programs before they reach the tuition cap threshold in the eligible program. Under no circumstances will recipients be eligible for cash payment, tuition credits or other compensation for tuition paid below the tuition cap threshold.
- The scholarship posting will be reported as “Other Aid” for financial aid purposes to be included in your cost of attendance calculation.
- The scholarship may decrease the amount of funding you are eligible to obtain from other sources, including federal financial aid.
- You understand and agree that this scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships offered by Strayer or tuition assistance aligned pricing (TAAP) discounts (also known as employer discounts).
- You understand and agree that the scholarship may not be combined with corporate alliance/national account discounts.
- You understand and agree that you are required to notify Strayer if your citizenship status changes.
- You understand and agree that this scholarship applies to tuition only. All other fees, including technology fee, final academic requirements evaluation fee, resource kits, books, course materials and non-obligatory fees must be paid by a separate method of payment.
- You understand and agree that you are required to notify Strayer if your citizenship status changes.
- You represent that neither you, an immediate family member or household member of yours are currently employed by Strayer, Strayer’s parent company or any other subsidiary of the parent company (Strategic Education, Inc.).
- You understand and agree that you are subject to all academic policies and procedures applicable to Strayer students, as provided for in the Strayer catalog and handbook.
- You agree to maintain, at a minimum, good academic standing as defined in the Strayer catalog and handbook during the entire time that you are receiving the scholarship. Any quarter following the quarter when you fail to maintain good academic standing, the scholarship will be forfeited until you return to good academic standing.

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- You understand that students enrolled in the LPN program are allowed one repeat of one course throughout the entire program. If a second course attempt results in a below average or failing grade (D or F), the scholarship will be forfeited and you will no longer be eligible to continue in the LPN program.
- You understand that if you choose to change to an ineligible program, discontinue or withdraw (either voluntarily or involuntarily), you will become ineligible for this scholarship and have all future scholarship disbursements canceled.
- You understand and agree that if you do not register for or drop all courses during a quarter where the scholarship is disbursed, you forfeit the scholarship for that quarter and will be responsible for all tuition amounts not otherwise covered by financial aid. If you register, but do not remain enrolled through the first two weeks of the quarter or billing session you will forfeit the award for the missed quarter or billing session. The missed quarter will count as an unenrolled quarter for purposes for continued scholarship eligibility.
- You understand that due to the nature of the LPN diploma, if you take time off, fail to maintain attendance for consecutive quarters or fail to follow the prescribed course sequence, you will forfeit the scholarship benefits.
- You understand and agree that you may not use the scholarship funds to pay for a repeat course, including repeats due to dropped courses that resulted in a final grade of WF or WP.
- You understand and agree that this scholarship has no cash value, and under no circumstance will you be eligible for a refund, cash payment or any other compensation for the value of unused scholarship funds and/or disbursements.
- You understand and agree that if your tuition is billed to an employer or sponsor, the scholarship is applied first to tuition charges and then the sponsor is billed the remaining net tuition amount.
- You understand and agree that in all cases, the scholarship is offered at Strayer's discretion.
- You understand and agree that regardless of your state of residency, you must complete your clinical requirements, fieldwork experiences, or other program requirements at Strayer's Washington, D.C., campus or at medical facilities in Washington, D.C., through an affiliation agreement between Strayer and the medical facility. Additionally, you understand that Strayer's Licensed Practical Nurse Diploma program will meet the educational requirements for professional licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse in the District of Columbia and you acknowledge and agree that you intend to seek licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse through the District of Columbia Board of Nursing.
