The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) is authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP), which was signed into law on March 11, 2021. HEERF III provides additional support to institutions of higher learning to continue to serve students during COVID-19. The amount allocated to Strayer University is based on Strayer's number of Federal Pell Grant recipients. Under HEERF III guidelines, 100% of the funds received by proprietary schools (e.g., Strayer University) must be paid directly to students.

In fulfillment of U.S. Department of Education (ED) reporting requirements, Strayer University is publicly reporting the following:

An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned the Grant Award Notification (GAN) & the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, 100% of the funds received to provide HEERF III grants to students.

Strayer University acknowledges signing and returning the Grant Award Notification (GAN) for student funding to ED. Strayer received its allocation of HEERF III funds on July 14, 2021.

The total amount of HEERF III funds the institution will receive or has received from ED.

Strayer University has received \$2,554,773.00.

The total amount of HEERF III funds distributed to students.

Strayer University paid an equal amount to all 9,552 eligible students. Each student received \$267.45 (totaling \$2,554,682.40) on July 22, 2021. At the close of the grant period, the remaining \$90.60 will be de-obligated to Strayer University and refunded back to ED.

The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive HEERF III grants and the amount they would receive.

Strayer University used completed 2021/2022 FAFSA data to determine the population of students who received HEERF III funds. Specifically, Strayer selected students who met all of the following criteria:

- Zero EFC (Expected Family Contribution)
- An AGI (Adjusted Gross Income) between \$1 and \$14,999
- Summer 2021 course enrollment

Instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the HEERF III grants.

Strayer University sent payment notifications, via email, to the 9,552 HEERF III grant recipients on July 22, 2021.
