

#### Strayer University Research Survey on the Impact of COVID-19 on Women in the Workforce

#### Overview

Over 2 million women left the workforce during the COVID-19 pandemic and millions of jobs primarily held by women (in retail, restaurant, travel and hospitality fields) have vanished without certainty they will return. Even as industries reopen, employment opportunities are still sluggish. At April's rate of job growth, it would take more than 2 years to regain pandemic losses.

Women account for 72 **percent** of Strayer University students. Strayer recognizes that continued education is key to helping women secure more stable, higher paying, and flexible jobs that will allow them to rejoin and advance in the workforce. To understand the current challenges facing women and find ways to support their continued education, Strayer commissioned a survey by Atomik research of more than 2,000 women.

#### Methodology

The online survey was served to an online survey of 2,009 women in the United States. The margin of error fell within +/- 2 percentage points with a confidence interval of 95 percent. The fieldwork took place between May 1<sup>st</sup> and May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Atomik Research is an independent creative market research agency.
