

PROPERO POLICY

Propero courses are graded as pass/fail. A minimum score of 70% in the course will be considered as passing in order to be eligible for academic credit.

Propero does not limit the number of times a student may retake a Propero course. Students would need to repurchase the course for each retake.

Credit from a Propero course does not apply toward the residency requirements for your degree program.

Propero courses are counted towards a student's total number of credits eligible to be transferred in.

The non-refundable fee for the proper course is \$269.

Once you complete and pass the Propero course in order to have your credit evaluated you will need to obtain an [ACE](#) (American Council on Education) transcript and have it sent to the University.

You will receive a copy of your evaluation in the mail. You are also able to obtain a copy from your home campus through the Admissions or Academic Offices.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

A student who is registered for courses at Strayer University is considered to be in residence. The following table lists the minimum hours in residence required for each certificate, diploma or degree program:
